Our preliminary task has been to build up our balance so that we can guarantee grants as they become necessary. Since the establishment of the Fund in 2020, we have provided grants to eight families.

Our Board of Directors believes strongly that, regardless of financial need, it is important to support families experiencing the heartache of the loss of a child (age 1-19 years.) Our grants are not based on financial need.
