WHAT WE'VE DONE SO FAR...

So far in 2022, we have been able to support 18 families with funds to use for funeral expenses. This brings the total to 34 families helped since we started in 2020. Our hearts break for these families, and we pray that the monetary support we offer alleviates some of the stress they are feeling.

At the end of May, we drew winners for a Weekend Getaway raffle. Nine generous individuals and businesses donated hotel, VRBO and AirBnB opportunities that were raffled off on Memorial Day.

For the second time, In June we were able to participate with other Chautauqua County non-profit organizations in an online event called GIVE BIG CHQ (https://www.givebigchq.org/info/faq). During this 24-hour fundraising event more than 40 donors chose to support our Fund with donations totalling over \$3000. We are overwhelmed by your support.
